TOUR 2: TUSCALOOSA'S UNTOLD HISTORY

CAPACITY IS 25

Did you know that America's largest city north of Mexico was once 13 miles from Tuscaloosa? Or that Martin Luther King, Jr. visited our First African Baptist Church?

First, you'll immerse yourself in the wonders of Moundville Archaeological Park, where over 800 years ago, the Mississippian people constructed 29 massive flat-topped earthen mounds. Marvel at the panoramic landscape and discover ancient treasures in the park's museum. A box lunch will be provided as you travel back to Tuscaloosa for the next part of the tour.

Then, journey through pivotal moments in Tuscaloosa's civil rights history. Hear firsthand accounts of Bloody Tuesday (June 9, 1964) at the historic First African Baptist Church and visit Foster Auditorium, where Governor George Wallace famously blocked the entrance of the first African American students who were admitted to the University of Alabama. Gain insight into Tuscaloosa's past and its significance in shaping America's narrative.

TOUR 4: T-TOWN'S OUTDOOR ADVENTURES OPTION A - CAPACITY IS 10

Do you enjoy being one with nature? To begin, we'll enjoy a bike ride along the Tuscaloosa Riverwalk, which follows the Black Warrior River that flows along Downtown Tuscaloosa. Tuscaloosa also has several lakes within 20 minutes of Downtown Tuscaloosa, so let's check one out. We'll travel to the Captain's Club, where we'll have a catered lunch overlooking Lake Tuscaloosa. You'll have the opportunity to enjoy a pontoon boat ride, paddleboard, or simply bask in the sun.



TOUR 4 : T-TOWN'S OUTDOOR ADVENTURES OPTION B - CAPACITY IS 10

If you're a fan of kayaking, this experience is for you. We've partnered with the Friends of Hurricane Creek for a guided trip down the last free-flowing Appalachian-type stream which can be seen before the Black Warrior River reaches the Fall Line at Tuscaloosa. TOUR 5: OUR CULTURAL TREASURES

CAPACITY IS 25

Are you a lover of art and beautiful architecture? Say no more! This tour will begin with tour two historic homes managed by the Tuscaloosa Preservation Society. First is the Battle Friedman House, built in 1835 and one of the only remaining documented antebellum gardens in the Alabama. The second is the Jemison-Van De Graaff Mansion, built between 1859-1862. It was the first in Tuscaloosa to have a fully plumbed bathroom and had its own gas plant to provide gas for illumination.

Next, we will visit Kentucky Arts Center in Historic Downtown Northport where you will tour the gallery, enjoy lunch from Billy's Sports Bar & Grill, and partake in an art activity that you can take home! Kentucky Arts Center houses several artists and has become globally recognized for its annual folk art festival that takes place each fall, with nearly 20,000 attendees!
